

## Job Description for CABIN LEADER

Purpose: To minister to the spiritual development of campers and staff that each may know Christ as Savior and grow in every area of living unto Him.

Responsible to: Program Director

Responsible for:

- A. The physical welfare of each camper assigned to you.
- B. Making opportunities to personally talk with EACH CAMPER about a personal relationship with Jesus Christ.
- C. At all times knowing the location of each camper assigned to you.
- D. Becoming familiar with and obeying camp policies and procedures.
- E. Participating in scheduled staff meetings.
- F. Welcoming campers as they arrive and introducing them to other campers, cabin leaders, facilities, and guidelines.
- G. Encouraging campers to take active parts in all activities.
- H. Helping your cabin plan its group activities.
- I. Ensure that each camper has signed up for the Sign Up Activity.
- J. Being prompt with groups at scheduled activities.
- K. Reporting symptoms of ill health promptly to the camp first aider.
- L. Consulting with the Program Director concerning any special needs.
- M. Supervising activities as assigned.
- N. Leading daily group devotions, Bible studies and other classes as assigned.
- O. Modeling and teaching a Junior Cabin Leader leadership skills.
- P. Supervising and participating in daily and final camp clean-up, checking for lost and found items.
- Q. Discreetly handling any bedwetting situation.
- R. Planning and leading rainy day activities.
- S. Being adaptable to help out in other activities.
- T. Sitting with your campers at meetings and campfires.
- U. Promptly and accurately filling out camp forms.
- V. Assisting campers in orderly week ending departures.
